2029

In 2029 I will be 65 years of age - retirement age. It prompted me to think about the legacy of my involvement in Sunnybank Rugby.

2029 is an interesting year for Sunnybank Rugby. It coincides with the following:

- 60 years since the club was formed
- 40 years since we first entered the QRU as an affiliate and participant in Premier Rugby
- The current 20 year lease with the BCC will expire
- In line with the lease the club will need to have expired all finance arrangements
- The Premier Colts team of 2029 is being born this year (2010)

Our community will undergo significant change with current local regional planning being finalised for Upper Mt Gravatt that will see the following for conclusion in the 2029-2031 window:

- Upper Mt Gravatt precinct earmarked as key employment, residential and economic growth area
- Mixed development planned near Logan, Kessels and Mt Gravatt-Capalaba roads, with buildings up to 20-storeys
- Logan Rd to house four to five-storey residential blocks that feature small mixed-use buildings which front the busy street

Most of the change in Rugby will occur in the near future with international imperatives restricting the opportunities for growth and development to the internal domestic environment.

- Rugby's share of the Australian sporting market had slipped from 22 per cent in 2003 to 13.7 per cent most likely by 2031 meaning almost all of our entire playing base in 2029 will not be alive for such an event:
 - 2015 UK
 - 2019 Japan
 - 2023 possibly South Africa (Sth Hemisphere & 28 years since last host)
 - 2027 most likely northern hemisphere
 - 2031 Australia???
- There will be Lions Tours in 2013 and 2025
- Argentina will join an expanded Tr-Nations (Four Nations in 2012)
- A 10 year IRB agreement will see a standard June incoming Test window which will involve a two- or three-Test series against only one visiting nation in June, with midweek matches also set to be incorporated at the agreement of the respective Unions

- Super 15 commences in 2011 which in non-RWC years will see competitive provincial Rugby each week from late February to the finals in early August
- Expansion of Super 15 is limited by the conference model which the most logical progression being limited to 1 additional team for each conference based on economic and regional development needs:
 - * South Africa: Southern Kings from the eastern cape (development)
 - * Australia: Japan (economic)
 - * New Zealand: Pacific Islands (development)

So what will Rugby at Sunnybank look like in 2029?

- There will be no Super 15 or Test players involved as players at a club level
- The need for successful competitions to be homogenous will ensure that the Queensland club Rugby will be amateur and social due to the lack of financial viability of other district clubs in Brisbane
- Increased population density will impose greater demand on green spaces like DM Henderson Park for a greater range of recreation pursuits
- The licensed club operations will hopefully conservatively have generated over \$50M in operating profits
- The units in Pepkin Trust on Mt Gravatt-Capalaba Rd will have been realised due to economic and demographic pressures
- The Rugby complex will have been completed with a players gym (2011) and upgraded clubhouse and canteen.

The options for Sunnybank Rugby include:

- Invest profits and unit returns in the economic property development of Upper Mt Gravatt for the benefits of Rugby and members
- Continue with the expansion of Rugby participation opportunities such as Browns Plains Dragons in growth suburbs such as Flagstone and Rochedale
- Investigate 3rd Tier participation opportunities for our players and the Sunnybank brand to bridge the gap between amateur social Rugby and professionally contracted Rugby

We have achieved so much since I first become involved in the club 22 years ago.

Everyone who has volunteered or played from 1969 until today has played a role in our current success and should be proud of their legacy. Days such as Old Boy's Day are an opportunity to stay engaged with your club.

Simply attending Old Boy's Day doesn't have to be it. Consider the following:

- You can become a financial member and have a real say in the future of your club
- As a member you can run for the committee and help to mould and lead the future vision

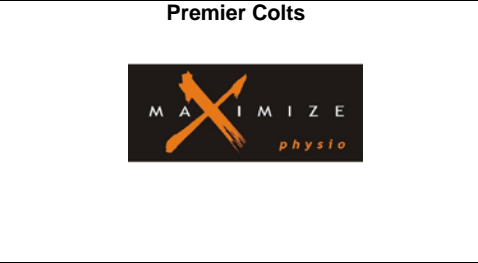
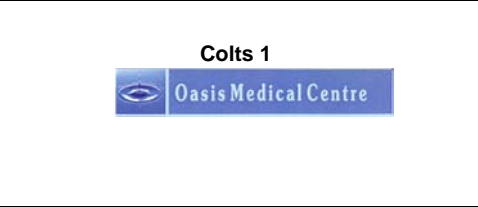

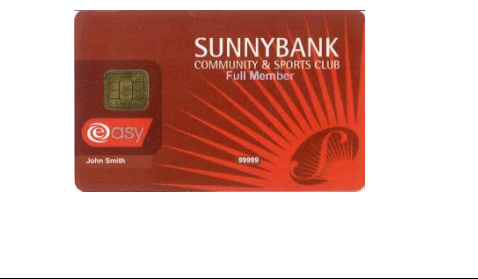
